New wheelie bin to replace your black boxes for recycling

Thank you for your efforts to recycle more of your waste. Because the amount we recycle is increasing each year we are introducing new wheelie bins to replace the black boxes for recycling. This will help to reduce the amount of litter on our streets and make collections less physically demanding for our crews.

We'll deliver your new blue-lidded wheelie bin to you in the next few weeks and you can start using your new bin straight away. Don't worry about putting this bin out for every collection if it's not very full, we understand that amounts of recycling can vary depending on the size of the household.

Your scheduled recycling collection day, and assisted collection if you have one, will be the same. You can check this at www.northyorks.gov.uk/har-bins


Please use the new blue-lidded wheelie bin for everything you currently put in your black recycling boxes only. A full list of what can go in the new wheelie bin is shown overleaf. To fit more in your bin wash and squash cans, tins, cartons and plastic bottles, and ensure everything is rinsed out as we can't collect recycling with food on it.

Please continue to use your blue recycling bag for all paper, card and cardboard. You can keep your old black boxes for storage or take them to your local household waste recycling centre.

Please remember to present your recycling (blue-lidded wheelie bin and blue bag) at your collection point by 7am on collection day.

Please...

- ✓ wash and squash cans, foil and plastic containers
- ✓ rinse jars and bottles



- ✓ glass bottles and jars of any colour
- ✓ plastic bottles, shampoo and cleaning product bottles with lids/trigger spray nozzles on
- ✓ plastic yoghurt pots, margarine tubs, light coloured and clear plastic food trays
- ✓ food tins/drinks cans (aluminium or steel)
- ✓ clean tin foil, foil trays and foil dishes
- ✓ food and drink cartons
- ✓ empty aerosol containers such as air fresheners, deodorant cans, shaving foam

Your blue bag is for



- ✓ brown cardboard and corrugated cardboard packaging - flattened and cut down to fit in the bag
- ✓ card including cereal boxes, food packaging (frozen food/ready meals), greetings cards and egg boxes
- ✓ catalogues and telephone directories including Yellow Pages
- ✓ clean paper bags (please remove any string)
- ✓ envelopes (including window)
- ✓ magazines, newspapers, brochures and unwanted mail
- ✓ office paper (any colour)
- ✓ shredded paper
- ✓ wrapping paper (no foil/glitter)
